
2.1 How to get around with useful materials


2.3 In-app help system

After you log in, you will land on the application home page. To access the details in the app help system, click on the "question mark" icon.






Use the headers from the table of contents to navigate to the help on different parts of the application.




On each page of the application, there is a "Question mark" icon. By clicking on this icon, you will be redirected to a specific feature in the help system.






2.4 Knowledge base

You can set up different contact settings that will be used for application support. You can set multiple email addresses of all people involved in the testing process, allowing users to get adequate help. For example, you can create one form for the instructor, one for the proctor, etc.

3 Custom email notifications for candidates

3.1 Good examples

Notifications allow users to automatically receive messages in the application and via email following any important actions. Here is how they work:

The most important notification is the one announcing to the candidate that they are assigned to take an exam. This notification should contain all instructions and information that candidates should acknowledge before taking an exam.

4 Cheating prevention mechanisms

There are several ways to prevent candidates from cheating:

- 1. <u>Question and answer randomization</u> change the order of questions and/or answers for each attempt.
- 2. <u>Browser lockdown</u> restrict access to certain browser features.
- 3. All or live proctoring Administrator's perspective and Candidate's perspective
